#### Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present

With a quorum present, the regular meeting of the Bee Cave City Council was called to order by Mayor Murphy at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 8, 2014 in the Council Chambers of the City of Bee Cave City Hall, 4000 Galleria Parkway, Bee Cave, Texas.

## **Pledge of Allegiance**

#### **Citizen Comments**

Maureen Appling, Bee Cave, commented that the presentation for the proposed projects, the Terrace and the Backyard at Bee Cave, should be at City Hall in a business like atmosphere not at the Backyard.

Adrian Overstreet, Managing Partner of the Hill Country Galleria, presented the Council with a shovel representing the ground breaking of the Sonesta Hotel.

Carrell Killebrew, 5410 Great Divide, commented that he did not see any compelling need for the City to grant a Public Improvement District for the Backyard project.

Robin Thigpin, 4300 Tambre Bend, spoke about the concert held at the Backyard over the weekend and how his family could not go outside because of the vulgar and foul language coming from the concert.

Stephen Dotson, 4121 Gandara Bend, also spoke in opposition to the concert held at the Backyard.

Geeta Balakrishnan, President of the Friends of the Library, commented that she supported the library being opened on Mondays.

Mr. Overstreet stated that he supported the replat and that four of the lots were ponds.

Mayor Murphy opened the public hearing at 6:26 p.m.

Mr. Overstreet stated that the lot is being re-platted to establish separate lots for the Sonesta Hotel and the drainage easement.

<u>Discuss and consider action on Ordinance No. 196 amending the Budget for fiscal year 2013-14.</u>

Council Member Auslander took her seat at the dias at 6:39 p.m.

Finance Director Katie Griffin presented this item. Additional funding requests totaling \$42,868 that have not been previously approved are being requested. These requests include the restoration of Monday hours at the Library including the addition of 1.5 FTEs (full time equivalents) and funding of FY13-14 of \$18,000 (impact for remainder of current year) for FY13-

14 and \$44,744 for FY14-15 (full year impact). The Library is also requesting funding of \$3,000 for OverDrive catalog integration.

The Police Department is requesting the conversion of the Municipal Court part-time warrant officer into a full time Warrant Officer with the salaries and benefits being split between the Police Department (1,184 hours) and the Municipal Court (1,000 hours). The financial impact for FY13-14 to the Police Department is \$16,068, with a reduction in overtime associated with school patrols. There will be no impact on the budgeted revenues associated with the school patrols. The Municipal Court financial impact for FY13-14 for benefits only is \$8,800 (may be reduced depending on hire date). The full year financial impact on FY14-15 for the Police Department is \$32,136 and \$8,800 for the Municipal Court.

Administration is requesting \$5,000 to obtain a third-party to conduct a salary survey.

Increased revenue projects are significant enough to cover all proposed additional funding requests.

**MOTION:** A motion was made by Council Member Auslander, seconded by Council Member Goodwin, to approve Ordinance No. 196 amending the budget for fiscal year 2013-14 including approval of the above additional funding requests.

<u>Discuss and consider action on appointing up to two members of the City Council to work</u> with developer on the Planned Development District for the Terrace and the Backyard at Bee <u>Cave.</u>

City Manager Frank Salvato presented this item. Chris Milam, Developer, is moving rapidly on his project and Mayor Murphy and staff want input from Council on whether Councilmembers should be appointed to assist with the PDD and PID development.

The City Council discussed this item at length. Members had different opinions on the appointment of two people to assist and others believed the City needs a policy to follow for all projects of this kind.

John Colman, 5201 Great Divide, commented that he thought the Council needs a policy. He said this project should be what the citizen's want not what the Council wants. He commented that the Homeowner Associations should be involved.

Bob Arrona, 5104 Gillians Walk, commented that everyone should hear the presentation from Mr. Milam. He stated that this project was too big for Bee Cave.

Mr. Killebrew stated that he wanted the project discussed in an open meeting.

Dean Appling, Bee Cave, stated that he was opposed to a policy that would allow one or two members to meet with the developer outside of a public meeting.

The Council discussed holding a town hall meeting.

No action was taken at this time.

Council Member Auslander left the meeting at 8:31 p.m.

## Discuss and consider a contract with Freese & Nichols, Inc. for engineering services.
